Kerosene and lard, kerosene emulsion, potato water and pyrethrum were experimented with upon infested animals the past winter with the following results:

KEROSENE AND LARD—Three parts of lard were melted in a dish, and then one part of kerosene was added, and the mixture thoroughly stirred.

KEROSENE EMULSION—An eight per cent. emulsion was applied to ten three year old animals kept in a barn.

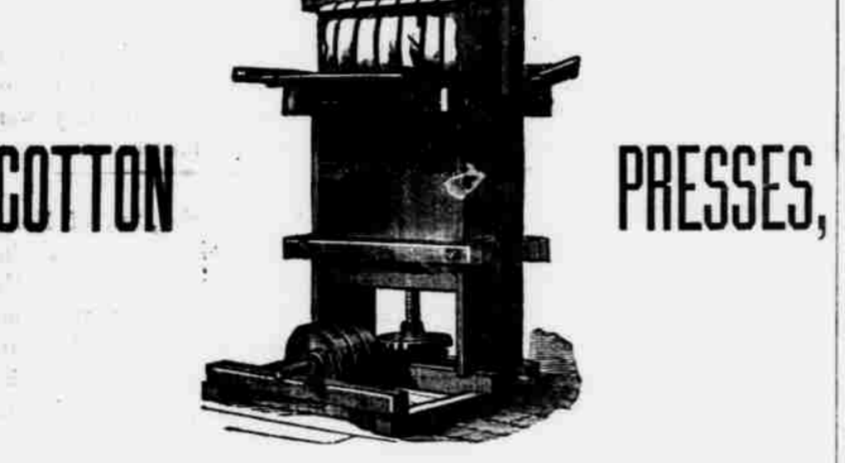

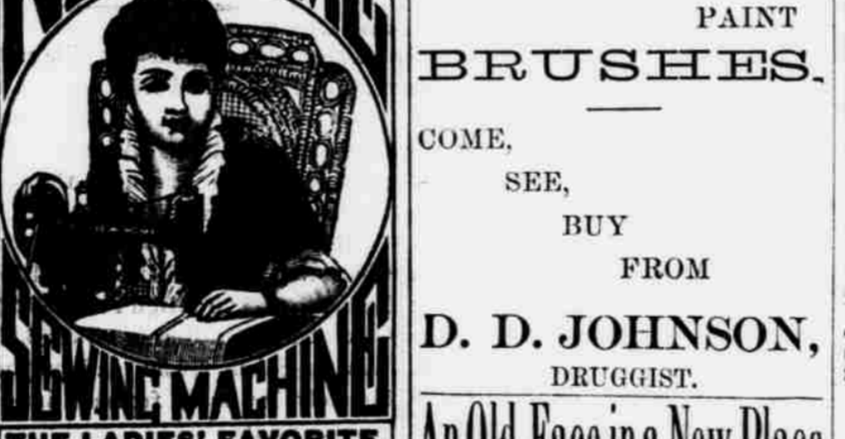
