AWFUL CRIME IN OMAHA.

An Eleven-Year-Old Girl Outraged and Then Choked to Beath,

OMAHA, Neb., Nov. 6 -Early this morning the police found the body of Ida Gaskin, aged 11, in a vacant room on Howard street. She had been outraged and then choked to death. She had been missing since last evening. Three young men, Ed. Sanford, George Morgan and Booder were arrested, charged with the murder.

The feeling against the prisoners became so strong during the day that it was decided to remove them from the city and they were hastily removed to the penitentiary.

The police are satisfied that Morgan, who is a teamster, is the rapist and murderer. More than 5,000 persons viewed the remains of the child at the morgue today and tonight a large crowd surrounds the jail from which the prisoners have been removed.

Sumner Not Guilty.

About seven months ago Ernest Sumner and Charlie West were shot from ambush and killed while riding along the road in Buncombe county, Jesse Sumner, a relative of the young man was arrested upon the charge of killing them and a true bill of murder was found against him by the grand jury of Buncombe Criminal Court. When the case was called for trial a motion was made by the attorneys of the defendant to move the case and Judge Ewart transferred it to Henderson county. The removal of the case was criticised by the Asheville Citizen and for this action Editor Robinson was adjudged guilty of contempt of court and sentenced to jail and fined. The case against Sumner came up for trial week before last and after a contest unprecedented in the history of the county a yerdict of not guilty was returned last Saturday night.
