

The young man belongs to one of the best families in this town and no man stood higher morally, or more thoroughly enjoyed the confidence of the people.





Through the St. Louis Tornado. Here is an illustration of the way the wind handled things during the big St. Louis tornado. This bicycle,



owned in St. Louis, was struck by three barrels of syrup, a tierce of lard and one barrel of vinegar. Absolutely the only uninjured parts are the saddle and the Morgan & Wright quick repair tires, which were full of air when the machine was found.
