A Notice for the Public.

It is the duty of every citizen to see to it that the health of the town is protected. The attention of the public is directed to the following ordinance which has been a law for many years in Concord, viz:

Ordinance No. 20: Any owner, leaser or renter of any premises or lot upon which there is a privy or hog pen within the corporate limits of said town, suffering said privy or hog pen to become offensive in smell shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction threof shall be fined \$20 or imprisoned for ten days.

The ordinance will be enforced and the policemen are instructed to report all such places not kept in a sanitary condition. These places should be cleaned and covered with dry dirt at least twice every week. Respectfully,




