Riddick, one of the defendants in said action is a non resident of the State of North Carolina and cannot, after due diligence, be found therein and cannot be personally served with process, and is a necessary party to this action, the same being an action for the sale of a tract of land for partition among the plaintiffs and defendants, containing 83 acres more or less, on the waters of Big Creek, in Stokes County, adjoining the lands of T. C. Hole and others, and being Lot No. 4 in the partition of the land of G. A. and N. C. Simmons, deceased, assigned to the plaintiffs and defendants as heirs-at-law of Mary Ann Riddick deceased.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that publication of notice be made for four successive weeks in the Reporter, a newspaper published in Stokes county, notifying the defendant Robt. L. Riddick, that an action as above entitled has been instituted against him and others in the Superior Court of Stokes County N. C., for the purposes above set forth, and requiring him to appear at the office of the Clerk of the superior Court of Stokes County, N. C., in Danbury, on or before the 11th day of June 1906, and answer or demur to the petition for sale. And let the defendant Robt. L.
