BRYAN COMING TO WINSTON.

Will Speak in the Twin-City On Tuesday Morning, Sept. 18th at 11:00 O'clock—Also to Deliver Addresses in Durham, Raleigh, Salisbury and Other Places.

Raleigh, Sept. 5.—Announcement is made from State Democratic headquarters here that Wm. Jennings Bryan will deliver speeches in North Carolina September 18 and 19. He will be at Hollins Institute near Roanoke, Va., September 15, to place his daughter in school there and will come directly into North Carolina. According to the itinerary arranged here subject to the approval of Mr. Bryan, he will come to Winston-Salem Monday and speak there Tuesday morning, September 18. In the afternoon he will speak at Greensboro and at Salisbury Tuesday night. Wednesday, September 19, he will come to Raleigh, speaking probably at Burlington and Durham en route. After his speech in Raleigh he will leave for Columbia, S. C., where he will speak Thursday, September 20, and then continue his Southern tour.

As soon as these dates are approved by Mr. Bryan arrangements will be made for special trains to some of the points, notably Winston-Salem, Greensboro, Salisbury and Raleigh.

Winston, N. C., Sept. 6.—The announcement that Mr. Bryan would deliver an address in Winston-Salem was gladly received here this morning. As soon as it was announced that the Nebraskan would visit the State, Chairman A. H. Eller, of the county Democratic executive committee, wrote to State Chairman Simmons, urging that a date be arranged for a speech in Winston-Salem and the city is to be congratulated on the fact that this was done.

Mr. Bryan's speech here will be his first in this state. It will be delivered Tuesday morning, September 17. Tuesday afternoon he will speak in Greensboro and in Salisbury at night. Wednesday morning he will speak in Raleigh.

While in the city Mr. Bryan will be the guest of Hon. J. C. Buxton at his home on Summit street.
