Letter From Campbell.

Campbell, Jan. 4, 1912. Mr. Editor: I think the time has come to make good roads in our county. It seems that the people are discouraged and out of heart who have to try to do any kind of business or farming in our county, on account of the hard way it is to do anything, to haul anything, or to make a dollar by stirring around during the rough weather of the year. I am a poor man, and do not own any land, and I know it would not cost me much to work the roads by taxation, my tax is only two or three dollars a year. I have to work the road just as many days as those who own hundreds of acres of land. Most of the land owners in my neighborhood are in favor of the tax for roads. If ever we have an election on the question I expect to vote the tax. If it made my tax double what it is, how could it help benefit the poor man. We will each one of us save \$6.00, as the six days of free labor are worth that to us. Then if we had a good level road, we could get out and stand a chance of making a dollar where we can't make 5 cents for several months in the winter time. Many farmers in my neighborhood would sell their farms and leave the county, on account of the dull outlook ahead. It is a long ways to market over a road which is dangerous to travel. You can put me down in favor of the tax for roads.

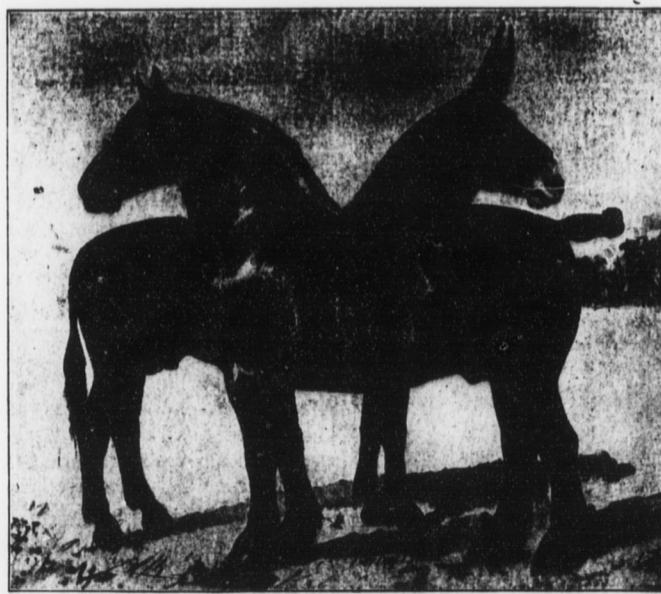
