## THOROUGH PREPARATION.

Don't Get In Too Big a Hurry To Plant Your Crop—A Late Spring Means A Late Fall.

March 8, 1912, To Demonstrators and Agents in Virginia, North and South Carolina:

We appreciate, that owing to the unusual winter, little work has been accomplished on the farms generally in your county, and, therefore, there is a great deal to be accomplished in a short time. For this reason we are fearful that our Demonstrators will become more or less discouraged and in their great anxiety to plant their crops in time will not give sufficient attention to the thorough preparation of their seed beds. We hold and I think that you will agree with us upon reflection, that it is the wiser policy to get your crops in a little late on a thoroughly prepared seed bed than at an earlier date on a poorly prepared one. Doubtless you have heard it said that half of the cultivation of the crop should be done before the seed is put into the ground. We see no reason for discouragement or alarm, for, generally speaking a late spring means a late fall. Nature provides for and takes care of us in this way. We sincerely hope that you will not forget the great importance of thoroughly preparing your seed beds. This office is now preaching the gospel of thorough preparation. Won't you help us spread it?
