ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$6,-000.00 WATER AND ELEC-TRIC LIGHT SYSTEM BONDS OF THE TOWN OF WALNUT COVE, NORTH CAROLINA.

Be It Ordained By The Board of Commissioners of The Town of Walnut Cove:

Section 1. That in pursuance of the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (Sections 2918 to 2965, Volume 3, Consolidated Statutes of North Carolina.) negotiable bonds, of the Town of Walnut Cove, to be known as "WATER AND ELECTRIC LIGHT SYS-TEM BONDS" are hereby authorized to be issued in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS, (\$6,000.00,) for the necessary expenses of said town to-wit: for the purpose of paying for the construction of a water and electric light system for the Town of Walnut Q Cove and its citizens.
