C. H. Martin Says
Better Buy License
To Hunt.**

Anyone who participates in the hunting of any wild bird or animal in North Carolina is required to have a hunting license except a person hunting on his own land or a person under sixteen years of age hunting on his parent's or guardians license. The opinion for participating in a hunt comes under the definition of the word "take." In other words, every one is required to have a license to take wild birds and animals. Take means the pursuing, shooting, hunting, killing, capturing, trapping, snaring, and netting birds or animals, collecting birds nests or eggs and all lesser acts such as disturbing or annoying birds or animals or placing or using any net or other device for the purpose of taking birds or animals whether or not they result in taking such birds or animals.

Certainly anyone participating in a fox hunt, whether they are the owners of the dogs or not, come within this definition and should be required to have a license.
