Mrs. Irene Slate Stoudemire, wife of Sterline Stoudemire, professor of Spanish in the University, died of a heart attack at about 10:30 o'clock last Saturday night at her home in Chapel Hill, on Gimghoul Road. She was thirty-five years old. Mrs. Stoudemire was active in the civic and social life of Chapel Hill. She was a grade mother at the school, took part in the Parent Teachers Association, and served as president of the North Carolina Junior Garden Club.

The funeral services were held Monday afternoon at the First Baptist Church, Spencer, where she lived until her marriage and where her parents, Dr. and Mrs. W. C. Slate and her brother, Lester H. Slate, live now. She is survived by her husband and a daughter, Miss Marian Stoudemire.

The floral offerings were unusually large and beautiful which was evidence of the esteem in which she was held.
