Farmers' Institute.

A Farmers' Institute will be held at Hickory, Wednesday, July 25, 1906. The object of a Farmers' Institute is to bring together the farmers in order that they may discuss the subjects relating to their business, such as the best methods of using fertilizers on various crops, the preparation and cultivation of the soil, stock-raising and stock-feeding, diseases of stock, grain and grass-growing, trucking, fruit-growing, improvement of worn soils, etc.

At the same place and date will also be held an Institute for Women. The objects of this Institute are to bring together the women from the farm homes that they may become better acquainted and talk over among themselves subjects tending to the betterment of conditions in rural homes, such as better and more economical foods and better methods of preparing them, home sanitation, home fruit and vegetable gardening, farm dairying, poultry raising, the beautifying of the home and home surroundings, etc.

Interesting programs have been prepared for both meetings. In addition to local speakers, H. H. Hume, State Horticulturist; F. T. Meacham, Supt. Iredell Test Farm; J. C. Kendall, Dairyman N. C. College of Agriculture; J. S. Jeffrey, Poultryman N. C. Agricultural Experiment Station; Miss Mae Card, Ontario Agricultural College, Canada; and Miss Vila Boddie, Industrial and Normal College, Greensboro, N. C., will be present and discuss questions of interest.

All farmers and their wives, sons and daughters and all others interested in farming and the betterment of the farm homes are urged to attend these meetings and join in the discussions. Morning session will open at 10 o'clock sharp, and afternoon session at 1:30.

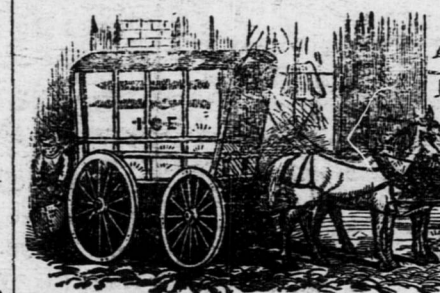
