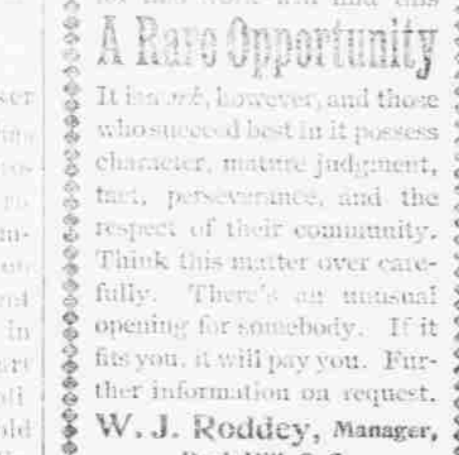
For more than two weeks past Mr. Devinity, the sexton of the cemetery in Rock Hill, has been examining and re-interring bodies buried in the grounds...
