Whereas, In this so-called history the sacred family relations four people are attacked and falsifiied in language impossible to quote here, and the very honor of our fathers and mothers grossly impugned; therefore,

Resolved, That the Maryland Division of the United Daughters of the Confederacy registers an indignant protest in the name of truth and justice against the use of Elson's so-called history in any of the schools, colleges or universities of our land, and calls on all Confederate veterans to aid the Daughters of the Confederacy in stamping out this vile publication and all similar ones, to the end that the youth of the country no longer be taught as facts untruths which are slanders on the fair name of the South, her institutions and her people."
