The disease is very deadly in Southern Europe, the Soudan and tropical Asia. It is called by the Arabs "Kalaazar," and in India is known as "Dumdum" fever. It has long been considered as a form of chronic malaria, causing irregular fever, enlargement of the spleen, and great wasting. It is endemic in India, China and the Soudan, in some of the Greek islands and in parts of Sicily. In Assam, some years ago, it appeared as an epidemic. and spread slowly up the Brahma-Putra Valley, killing off practically the whole population in village after village. The disease is attributed to the bite

of a mosquito.


