The Winston Journal asks what if the allies should lose, what will become of the billion dollars we loaned them, a more pertinent question would be what will become of the United States should Germany win. If it ever happens it will be a question that will trouble statesman much.

We doubt the propriety of such a thing, Mr. Bryan has shown his cloven foot in a decidedly unfriendly way, not only to this government but to Mr. Wilson. We doubt there is any good he could accomplish.

It has been England's announcement that it had so effectually blockaded the ports of Germany as to starve its people out but it now seems that Germany is making England pay a staggering sum for the part she is taking in the starving out process, the sum so enormous as to threaten the English Kingdom with irretrievable bankruptcy. Some change must soon be made in the military tactics of the allies, or an awful condition will face them. We are sorry to have to look at the matter in this light, but we can see it in no other.

At that time Mr. Fairbrother was not a warm admirer of Mr. Joseph Daniels and made it a point to write some strong stuff about him usually of a humorous character. There was a number of things in Durham at that time he did not like, and he never hesitated to say so. We have been an admirer of Mr. Fairbrother's writing. We trust he will recover from his present illness and will yet be able to do much work with his pen.

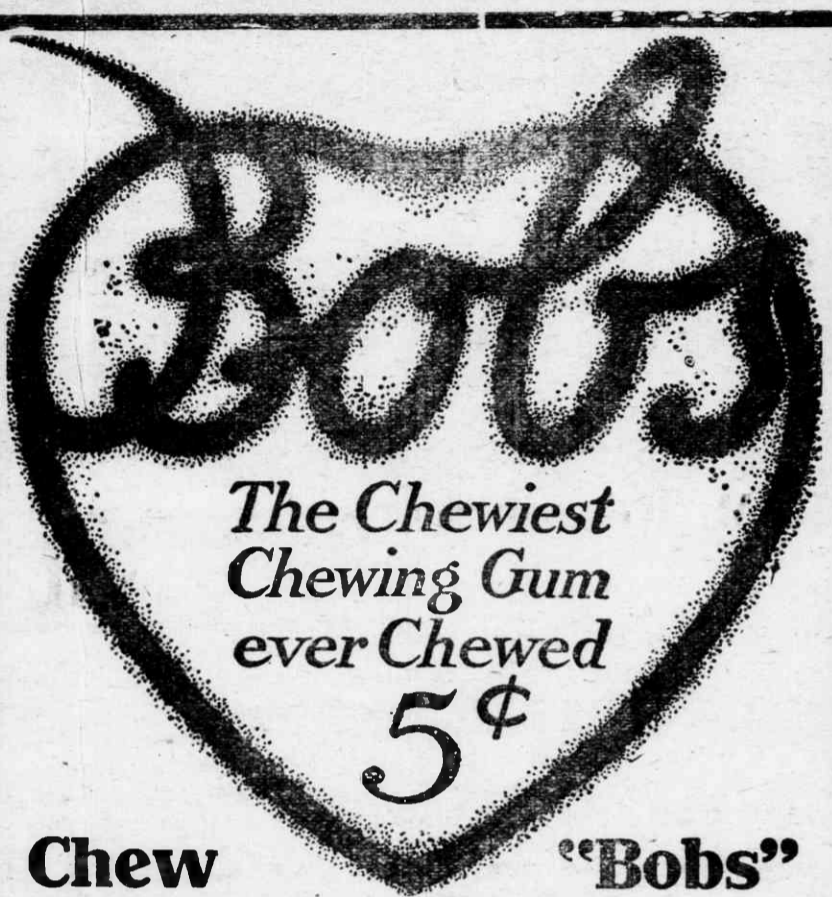
