

When torpedoed the Stanley was nearing the Irish coast, and as the men were taking to the boats, the submarine fired upon them and the ship with a deck gun, the survivors asserted. The men killed by the explosion of the torpedo were three engineers and two firemen.

Two boats were lowered. The one tained the men picked up by the Port since.

The other drifted for 76 hours before being sigted by the Port / Ibany. This boat had on board Chief Officer Cole, chief engineer Jenkins and 15 of the crew. The officers said they could not recall the name of the American. His home was in Newport News.

The Stanley was a ship of 3,987 tons gross, 390 feet long and was built at West Hartlepool in 1914. She was owned by the Pyman Steamship company of West Hartlepool.


