Troops Pursue Raiders

Across Border; Kill Six.

Eagle Pass, Tex., Dec. 30.—At least six Mexican bandits were killed in a fight between bandits and United States troops and Texas rangers Saturday at San Jose, Mexico, opposite the Indio ranch, which is 20 miles south of Eagle Pass, according to an official statement received here today at military headquarters. The Americans had crossed into Mexico on the trail of Mexican cattle thieves. There were no American casualties.

After the bandits, said to have numbered 50, were routed, the Americans returned to the Texas side. The pursuit of a "hot trail" across the border followed a series of raids on the Indio ranch, in which it is estimated that a thousand or more head of cattle had been driven across the Rio Grande.
