

Eagle Pass, Tex., Dec. 30.—At least six Mexican bandits were killed in a fight between bandits and United States troops and Texas rangers Saturday at San Jose, Mexico, opposite the Indio ranch, which is 20 miles south of Eagle Pass, according to an official statement received here today at millitary headquarters. The Americans had crossed into Mexico on the trail of Mexican cattle theives. There were no American casualties.
