## Liberty Loan Will

-Washington, D. C.-Preaident WIIson signed the third Liberty Lean bill late on Thurnday. The bonds will mature in 10 years on Sept. 15, 1928,
and will bear interest from May
net and will bear interest from May ${ }^{\text {a }}$ next payable sem
15 and March 15 .
The third Liberty Loan campaign will last for four weeks, beginning April 6 and ending May 4, the Treasury Department has announced. Banks will be given five dayn after the campaign's close to tabulate and report subseriptions. Instead of 2 per cent cash payment with the subscription, as in the second loan, 5 per cen will be anked for the third loan. Twenty per cent then will be due May 28,35 per cent July 18 and 40 per cent August 15.
The Treasury expects many subacribers to pay in full on purchase, and these early payments may be sufficient to redeem the $\$ 900,000,000$ cer tifeates of indebtedness falling due before May 9. Otherwine, it may be necessary to refund the certificates
with other short time lots. Officialn also believe the May 28 payment actually will be much greater than the 20 per cent required.
