#Washington, D. C .- President Wilion signed the third Liberty Loan bill late on Thursday. The bonds will mature in 10 years on Sept. 15, 1928, and will bear interest from May 9, next payable semi-annually on Sept. 15 and March 15.

The third Liberty Loan campaign will last for four weeks, beginning April 6 and ending May 4, the Treasury Department has announced. Banks will be given five days after the campaign's close to tabulate and report subscriptions. Instead of 2 per cent cash payment with the subscription, as in the second loan, 5 per cent will be asked for the third loan. Twenty per cent then will be due May 28, 35 per cent July 18 and 40 per cent August 15.

The Treasury expects many subscribers to pay in full on purchase, and these early payments may be sufficient to redeem the \$900,000,000 certificates of indebtedness falling due before May 9. Otherwise, it may be necessary to refund the certificates with other short time lots. Officials also believe the May 28 payment actually will be much greater than the 20 per cent required.

The payment dates have been arranged so none shall come in June, when the drain of the country's financial resources will be great on account of income and excess profits taxes due June 15.

Within an hour after President Wilson signed the Bond Bill the first complete bond of the third Liberty Loan came from the bureau of engraving and printing. It was a \$50 "baby bond" and was carefully laid aside by James L. Wilmeth, director of the bureau, for special disposition to be determined later. Forty thousand more bonds will be ready today, 100,-000 by Saturday and thereafter they will be turned out at the rate of 500,-000 a day to supply demands for cash sales and immediate delivery.






