We have been spared this terrible memory. our minds cannot grasp the vision of such suffering, because we have not seen it with our eyes. 3.334 of these little ones are en-

trusted to North Carolina. We feed them or they perish. \$5.00 will save a life a month, and \$60.00 will take care of one of these little ones for one year.
