

IS CRUSHED TO DEATH

Miss Eva Moss, Dangling Aid-Air, Is Unable to C Back To Airplane

Cleveland, Tenn., Oct. 13 .- Da ling in mid air, unable to climb be to the airplane and afraid to the to a drop into a lake below, Miss Eva Moss, Chattanooga stunt flyer, this, afternoon, was fatally cru when the aviator was forced to deccend.

Pooing the fact that the day was Friday and the date the thirtsenth, Miss Moss went up for an exhibition flight, and had clambered out onto the wing of the plane, then let self down the 25-foot rope where she was suspended in mid-air by her teeth.

When the time came for the y oman to climb back to the airp either by reason of exhi through becoming entangled in the rope of the ladder she was unable to do so. The pilot seeing her pre ment, flew over a lake and circled about as low as possible, at the same time calling and signaling to her to jump into the water.

Whether through fear or inability to do this is unknown but she mained clutching at the end of the rope. In the meantime the mech cian observing the tragedy which was being enacted in the air hurriedly summoned an ambulance and physicians which were waiting when the

plane finally descended. In landing the young woman was thrown against the ground with a terrific impact after which she was dragged for 50 or 100 feet be the airplane came to a stop. She lived for 20 minutes, but never regained con

Aviator Peebles, with whom Miss Moss was flying, is heartbroken over the tragedy and his wife is prostrat of never again flying.

Only a week ago when making her first parachute jump from an airplane the young woman sustained a sprained ankle.
