TOBACCO ACREAGE LESS BY 18,000 THAN IN 1924

Only Bright Flue-Cured in East and Dark-Fired of Tennessee and Kentucky Increase.

Washington, July 11.—The department of agriculture estimated today that the total area planted to all types of tobacco this season would show a decrease of about 18,000 acres under last year.

Only two types, the bright flue cured of the eastern seaboard and the dark fired types of Tennessee and Kentucky, show increases, but they are offset by decreases in other types, ranging from three per cent in burley to 15 per cent in the western dark fired.

Small acreage, the department pointed out, was due to bad weather conditions and although planting was still in progress July 1 there was general complaint that the farmers would not be able to put their full acreage.

Preliminary estimates place the area planted to bright flue cured tobacco this year at 803,000 acres, which is an increase of 26,000 acres over last year. The increase is found in the new belt in Georgia, Florida and eastern North Carolina, while the old belt, Virginia and North Carolina shows a decrease of 14,000 acres and South Carolina shows no change.

Although the dark fired type show increases in Kentucky and Tennessee other sections report decreases and the general area planted to this type is estimated at 11,000 acres less than last year.

The air cured group fell off altogether about 2 1-8 per cent with Maryland and eastern Ohio being the heaviest losers with a decline of 11 per cent. Cigar types, collectively, show a decline of 11 per cent with an indicated acreage of 143,000 against 160,650 acres last year, the decrease being uniformly distributed throughout the territory.
