

This recognition comes to North Carolina, the third southern state to be admitted, as a result of a recent investigation by the federal census bureau of the completeness of the registration of deaths for that part of North Carolina that is not already in the registration area, namely, the rural section and the towns that had less than 1,000 population in 1910. The result of the investigation shows that 94.26 per cent of all deaths occurring in the state are registered, the standard required of all states in order to be admitted into the registration area being 90
