Washington, May 24.-Reprepresentative Webb thinks his bill in the House authoriziog the development of miveral rêsources in land of the:A ppalachian Forest Reserve will pass easily.
The measure was reported unani mously today from the Committee of Agriculture and Mr. Webbasked that it be put on the unanimous consent calendar. Secretary Houston of the Department of Agriculture approves it.
If the measures becomes law i will help Western North Carolina where there are rich deposits o aolin, mangaveseland mica. Th mica deposits begin within 50 miles
of Charlotte, in Cleveland county, and are found thickly deposited in Mitchell, Yancey and Avery Coun ties. The mica sells for from 10 cents to $\$ 26$ per pound.
Secretary Houston makes the following explanation of the value of the legislation, which he aproves:
"In the lands where an absolute fee is being acquired and there a: certain deposits of mica, kzolin and manganese and iron, the Govern ment of course owns the minerals. Generally these deposits occur in pockets which can readily be developed and worked out by small operators without much equipment or investment.
There is considerable demand or opportunity to work these de pesits, and some plan is needed by which the Secretary of Agriculture can permit them to be opened up and worked without title to the States passing out of the Uinin operations under proper regulation would not damage the forest or the protective covering of the water shed to any material degree on a count of the smallness of the de posits which are usually found in the pocket formation.
