Adamson Eight-Hour Law Held Unconstitutional.
The Adamson 8-hour law was hêld unconstitutional by Judge William C. Hoos in the United States District Court at Kansas City. The court made it plain that the decision was not based on mature consideration of the merits of the cfse but on expediency desired by all parties at interest because of the necessity of a final decision of the Supreme Court of the United States before January= next, when the law goes into effect.
