Just by way of reminder, although an unpleasant one to some, The Philadelphia Record says that in April, 1908, when Theodore Roosevelt was President, the Dingley tariff was in operation, the Republicans held both houses of Congress, and Providence accordingly should have smiled upon this blessed land, there were 413,000 idle freight cars standing upon the tracks of American railroads. Business was depressed, and continued so for several years. On November 1, 1916, within a week of a presidential election, which generally has a deterrent effect upon commerce, there was a shortage of 108,010 freight cars, or a difference of some 521,000 from the days of the Rooseveltian panic. With the re-election of a Democratic President the shortage daily grows worse.—Charlotte Observer.

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Adamson Eight-Hour Law Held Unconstitutional.

The Adamson 8-hour law was held unconstitutional by Judge William C. Hook in the United States District Court at Kansas City. The court made it plain that the decision was not based on mature consideration of the merits of the case but on expediency desired by all parties at interest because of the necessity of a final decision of the Supreme Court of the United States before January next, when the law goes into effect.

Council for the government asked Judge Hook to instruct the receiver for the Missouri, Oklahoma and Gulf railroad, complainant in an injunction suit, to join with the defendant in proceedings which would consign the case on its merits to the Supreme Court of the United States. The court was asked to dismiss complaint and declare the law valid. The court overruled the motion, holding the law invalid, and the case goes to the Supreme Court for early determination.
