The Farm Loan Act.
First Mr. Millseps tells us that the county will be the unit of the National Farm Loan Associations. Now Mr. Camp says he thinks be can get a ruling that smaller organizations can be formed. If this is done two or three associa tions may be formed in the count.y. The smaller organizations would seem to encourage cooperstion and stimulate the growth of a community spirit more than the large unit. With the latter the whole thing would become an of ficial matter lacking mutual neighborly interest. Mr. Camp also advises that appraising the land be left till the land banks open for business in January To date over $\$ 30,000$ in loans have been asked for.
The object of the Federal Farm Loan Act is to provide farmers with long time loans ( 5 to 40 years) at low rate of interest and to arrange so part of the principal can be paid each year. It seems likely that the rate of interest will be about $5 \%$. If so, a man who borrowed $\$ 1,000$ on 40 years time would have to pay yearly $\$ 50.00$ interest and $\$ 8.28$ on the principal. A total of $\$ 58.28$ each year would pay the entire debt, both interest and princial. A loan of $\$ 500.00$ would call for a payment each year of $\$ 29.14$.
