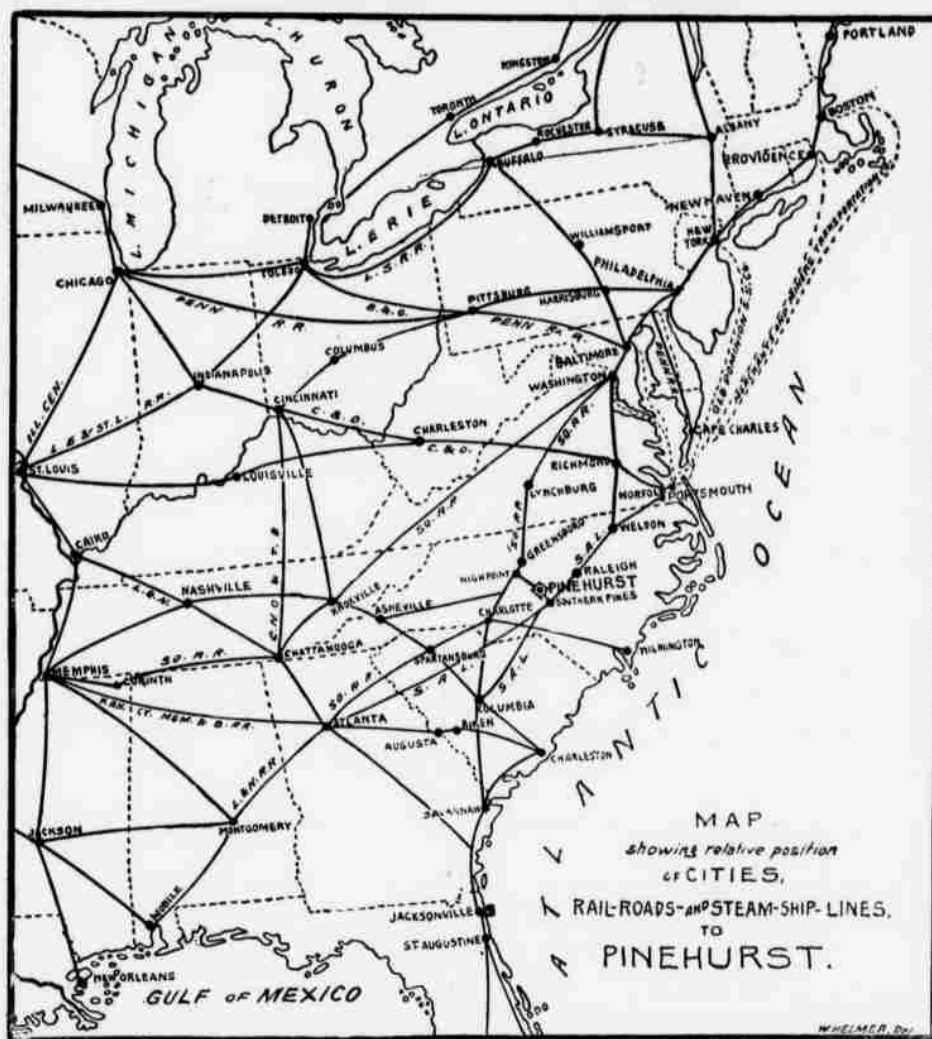

ROUTES FROM THE NORTH TO PINEHURST, N. C.

AND COST OF THE TRIP.



THERE are various ways of reaching Pinehurst which may be chosen according to individual preference by boat or by all rail. For one whose main object is to get to his journey's end with as little expenditure of time as possible the best route is by rail.

NEW YORK PASSENGERS.

The Washington and Southwestern Limited, leaving New York by Penn. R. R. at 4.25 p. m., Philadelphia 6.55 p. m., Baltimore 9.11 p. m., and Washington over Southern Railway at 10.45 p. m., connects at High Point, N. C., at 7.50 a. m. with a special train for Pinehurst which is reached (except Sundays) at 11.00 o'clock the following morning, eighteen and one-half hours from New York. Fare for round trip from New York, \$26.50. Proportionate fares for round trip from Philadelphia, Baltimore and Washington. Effective January 3, 1901. A special Pullman car will be Washington for Pinehurst without change. Sleeper ready for occupancy at 8.30 p. m. on arrival of the "Congressional Limited" from New York.

A midnight train leaving New York (Pennsylvania railroad) at 12.15 a. m., reaches Southern Pines at 9.35 the following night. Sleeper open at 10 p. m.

A train leaving New York at 1 p. m. by Pennsylvania railroad, reaches Southern Pines at 5.57 a. m. the following morning.

The Old Dominion Line of steamers from New York, the Bay Line and the Chesapeake Line steamers from Baltimore, the Norfolk and Washington steamers from Washington, and steamers on the Cape Charles route, all stop at Portsmouth, Va., and connect with Seaboard Air Line trains for Southern Pines.

The fare for round trip from New York City to Southern Pines, via Pennsylvania railroad and Cape Charles route or via steamers from Baltimore and Washington to Portsmouth is \$25.15, and on any other of these routes is \$26.25 and are limited to six months from date of sale. Single fare, \$15.95.

Passengers having through tickets, who desire to go by train and avoid night travel, can leave New York at 1.00 p. m. (Pennsylvania railroad) checking baggage through to Pinehurst, reach Richmond same evening at 10.30, spending the night there, leaving Richmond at 2.40 p. m. and arriving at Southern Pines at 9.35 p. m.

An afternoon may be spent in Washington by taking train from New York at 8.00 a. m. (Central Railroad of N. J.), leaving Washington on the evening boat (Norfolk and Washington steamer) at 7 p. m., making close connections with train which leaves Portsmouth (Seaboard Air Line) at 9.30 a. m. and reaches Southern Pines at 6.09 p. m.

BOSTON PASSENGERS.

SOUTHERN RAILWAY ROUTE. Train from Boston for Washington (without change) leaves Boston at 9.00 a. m. arrives at Washington at 9.45 p. m. and connects with the Southern Railway for High Point and Pinehurst, twenty-six hours from Boston. Fare for round trip, \$37.50. Tickets good for return until May 31st.

Special Pullman Sleeping Car Service.—Northbound. Effective January 3, 1901. The Southern Railway will operate through Pullman service between Pinehurst and Washington, leaving Pinehurst Mondays and Wednesdays at 7 p. m., connecting with through trains to all points North. Southbound. Every Tuesday and Thursday special Pullman Dining Room and Sleeping Cars will leave Washington at 10.45 p. m. for Pinehurst without change. Car open for occupancy at 8.30 p. m.

SEABOARD AIR LINE RAILWAY. Train from Boston for Washington (without change) leaves Boston at 7 p. m., arrives at Washington at 10.32 a. m., leaves Washington at 6.55 p. m., and reaches Southern Pines over Seaboard Air Line at 5.36 a. m. Round trip fare \$37.25, good for return six months from date of sale. Through tickets may be purchased and baggage checked to Pinehurst via Seaboard Air Line Railway.

Effective March 25. The Seaboard Air Line Railway, in connection with the Pennsylvania Railroad, will operate through sleeper between Washington, D. C., and Pinehurst, N. C., leaving Washington daily except Saturday and Sunday, train No. 31, at 6.55 p. m. Leaving Pinehurst daily except Saturday and Sunday, arriving Washington 8.40 a. m., having direct connections on same train from and to New York.

The Pinehurst Electric Railroad connects with trains at Southern Pines.
