47. The Robinhurst Cup, value \$35.00, for the best solid color dog, other than black, in the Novice or Limit Classes, bred and shown by a member. To be won three times at shows which give three points.

48. The Overcross Trophy No. 2 for the best parti-colored puppy. To be won four times with different puppies. Bred and owned by exhibitor.

49. The Hickory Trophy No. 2, for the best in the Novice Classes bred by a member. To be won five times with different Cockers. Donor not to compete.
