Mr. and Mrs. Lawrence Barr, who were here earlier in the season, returned this week from a trip north and are at the Carolina.

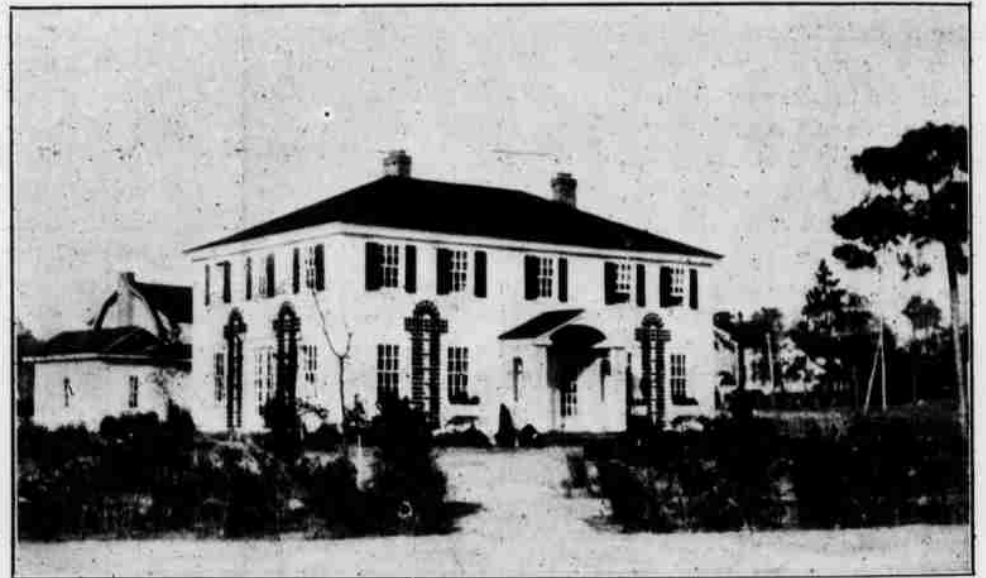
Mr. and Mrs. F. J. Weckesser and daughter, Miss Marion, are making their annual visit to Pinehurst and are at the Carolina.
