

The semi-final round provided less exacting contests for both Parson and Reekie. Parson went out in 38 against John F. Dailey, Jr., of Rochester, and won by 5 and 4. Reekie defeated Rusty Brown by 4 and 2.

Then came the big upset in the final, in which Parson started out by winning the first hole with an eagle 3 and ended up by taking the match by 2 up on the home green. Parson lost the second hole, after hooking his drive to the railroad tracks, but won the fourth and fifth with a birdie score on each of them. He lost the long seventh to Reekie's par 5 but was still 1 up at the turn, where he arrived in 36 to Reekie's 37.

Starting towards home. Reekie won the tenth when Parson drove into a trap, but, beginning with the twelfth, Parson took three in a row and was 3 up when they started for the fifteenth.

Reekie won that hole with a perfect 3 and reduced his disadvantage to 1 down at the sixteenth, which he annexed with a well played 4.

Neither finalist did anything to be proud of after that. They halved the seventeenth in 4's and Parson, after slicing his drive for the eighteenth hole, won the hole and the match, by 2 up, when Reekie missed a sizeable putt and a shorter one and lost his chance for an extra hole settlement.
