The entrance for targets and trophies for each event (with the exception of the Midwinter Handicap) is 3 cents a target. The winter of the Midwinter Handicap is guaranteed \$350.00.

One Hundred Target Handicap Tournaments.—Starting on Tuesday, November 13, there will be a weekly handicap tournament every Tuesday if there are five entries or more, for a sterling trophy, Ideal Leggett traps, bird handicap. The handicap is limited to twenty birds.
