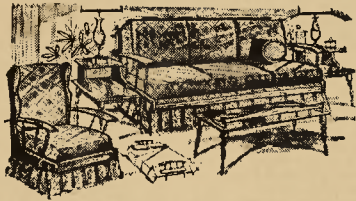

MILWAUKEE - Members of the late F. W. Spivey family met Sunday, December 12, at the Milwaukee Community Building for their annual Christmas reunion.

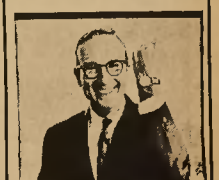
