chal, the exposure was well-deserved.

Paschal kept the scorekeeper busy all day, pouring in a school-record 38 points, including 27 in the second half. And Paschal gave the television commentators plenty of opportunities to heap on the praise, making 17 trips to the free-throw line and connecting on 14.

"I just thought that the guards got the post players good passes inside," Paschal said, "and we were just looking to shoot the ball if we were open.

"I was open, and I just took the shots."
Even when Paschal wasn't in the clear, the FSU offense clicked. Seminole head coach Marynell Meadors praised her bunch's heady offensive execution for that.

execution for that.

"When we had a layup or fast-break

opportunity, we took advantage of it," Meadors said. "When we didn't have it, we were very intelligent. We set it up and ran our offense, and we were very effective that way."

But in the end, Meadors credited her But in the end, Meadors credited her team's tenacious defense and gutty glasswork for allowing the Seminoles to pull away after holding only a 33-30 halftime advantage. "What we did in the second half was

that we came out and played more solid defense," she said. "We upped our de-fensive pressure on them and didn't allow them to do what they wanted to

"I think what you saw was just a bunch of kids that were really playing hard on defense and denying them the opportunity to come back on us." There was little doubt that on this

day, Florida State simply outplayed the Tar Heels. The stat sheet showed that:

■ UNC shot 43.3 percent for the ame; FSU shot 49.1 percent.
■ The Tar Heels committed 20 turnovers to Florida State's 13.

■ The Seminoles came up with 19 steals; UNC had nine.

One set of numbers that particularly caught Hatchell's eye came at the free-throw line, where the Seminoles hit 31 of 39 attempts. UNC, meanwhile, attempted 12 free throws, hitting 10.
"From the three, four and five play-

ers, 34 of our 60 shots were in the paint,"Hatchell said. "I mean, you think you'd get fouled on some of those. I

"We had 24 fouls and they had 11. And they played man-to-man the whole game. I don't know."

After reeling off nine consecutive ainst soft non-conference foes the Tar Heels have dropped two straight league contests. UNC's nine victories came by an average of 32.8 points.

"One reason for our non-conference schedule was that we knew we had to replace the point guard position," Hatchell said.

Emily Johnson, the starter at the point the past four seasons, graduated and is now a UNC assistant coach. That has left the job to sophomore Jill Suddreth. "We were trying to have some games

"We were trying to have some games where (Suddreth) could get some experience and confidence," Hatchell said.
While disappointed by Sunday's showing, UNC's coach vowed that her Tar Heels would return.
"We're going to get a lot better," Hatchell said. "I promise you that."
