NHL

Vancouver Canuck "Russian Rocket" Pavel Bure, Detroit Red Wing Sergei Federov, Boston Bruin Dmitri Kwartalnov and Darius Kasparaitis of the New York Islanders, to name just a few.

Not exactly household names like Joe Montana and Michael Jordan. But the talent is there.

"I think the addition of some of the European players who have tremendous skills, those that are in the league, is a real plus to the league," Bettman said.

The NHL doesn't have to go abroad to find a new pool of talent. Manon Rheaume broke the gender barrier in major pro sports this season when she played a period in an exhibition game for the Tampa Bay Lightning.

Rheaume is now on the roster of the Atlanta Knights, a minor league team of the Lightning. She has only played in one game, but has been practicing regu-

larly with the team.

Another way the NHL is attracting more fans other than female athletes and teal uniforms (the Sharks) is with so-called "neutral-site" games and ESPN coverage. The league added two games to each team's schedule to be played at arenas that are not home to either team.

ESPN won over the NHL with money and took national hockey coverage from the clutches of premium cable SportsChannel.

"It's great to be on ESPN again, and we're looking forward to working with them," Bettman said.

The NHL has been criticized in the

past for its excessive violence. The goonery in the league was out of control in the past few years, but this year with a new rule former president Gil Stein instituted, fighting is down 50 percent.

In fact, an instigator penalty now results in disqualification from the game and possible league fines and/or suspensions.

Despite the problems in the league this year, Bettman remains optimistic. "The NHL is having a good season," Bettman said. "It's unfortunate that many of our stars have been injured or ill, but sometimes that's the case with all things. I wouldn't read too much into it based on one season."
