University Transportation Planner Raymond Magyar said in an interview after the meeting that he was not sure the University would buy the system from the town.  
"This University has never attempted to do anything like this before," he said. "We have never had to run anything as massive as an entire bus transit system."  
Transportation planners also suggested eliminating unpopular routes to help save money to buy new buses. But council member Julie Andresen said this plan would not solve the problem.  
"If we reduce service, then we have a slightly decreased number of riders," she said. "That is not going to help us raise money for the buses in the long run."

Other options included raising fares for riders, increasing property taxes for Chapel Hill residents or eliminating the town trolley system.  
Werner said he thought the new buses would be a risky investment for the taxpayers.  
"With the way the current trends are going, these new buses could turn out to be a white elephant if we can't afford them," he said. "We run the risk of pricing ourselves out of a mass-transit system."  
He added that the town could make the transportation budget a bond issue in which case the public would vote to increase their own taxes. But Broun said he thought it would not pass because most people who vote in bond elections do not ride buses.
