Powell said she plans to begin active campaigning in mid-August or September.

The council seats of Julie Andresen, Brown, Powell, Alan Rimer and Art

Werner are open.

The candidate who receives the fifth highest vote will finish the remaining two years in Powell's term.

Werner is the only incumbent who has decided not to run.

Andersen said that in the next few

weeks she will decide whether to run for re-election. Rimer announced last Wednesday that he would be seeking re-election.

Candidates can file for the Nov. 2 election with the Orange County Board of Elections until noon, Aug. 6.
