Fate clashes with reality in 'Sleepless'

It's not unfair to compare "Sleep-less" to "Harry Met Sally." In fact, it begs for comparison. Not only does "Sleepless" have the same leading ac-tress as "Harry Met Sally," it's directed by Nora Ephron, who wrote the screen-play for the first movie. And "Harry Met Sally" director Rob Reiner makes Met Saity "director Kob Reiner makes an appearance in "Sleepless," too, as Sam's friend who gives him advice about women of the '90s. But even if "Sleepless" has an un-likely plot, it has its memorable high

Hanks' superb performance as the rare sensitive man barely keeps the young Malinger from stealing the show. The best scenes in the movie involve the father-and-son pair. In one scene, in which Jonah sees his father kissing a woman the son doesn't like. Jonah vells, 'Help! My dad's been captured by a ho!

Burnette, who is a member of the Blue-Ribbon Task Force and has a child in the school system, said she has a vested interest in the system.
