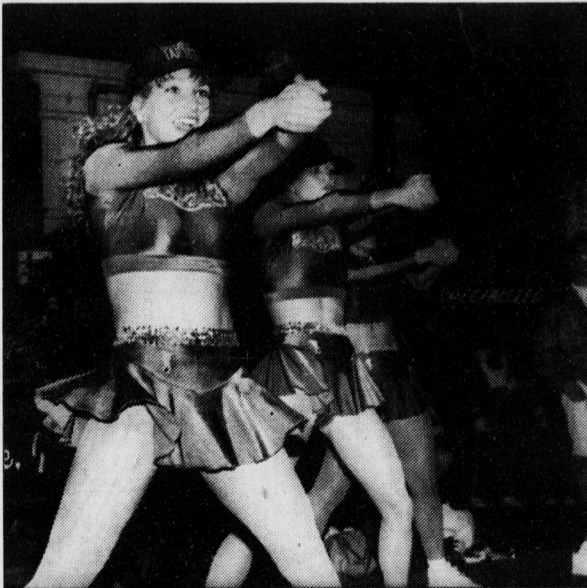
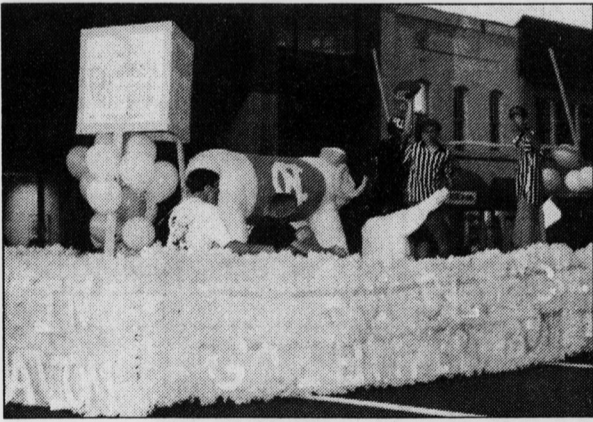
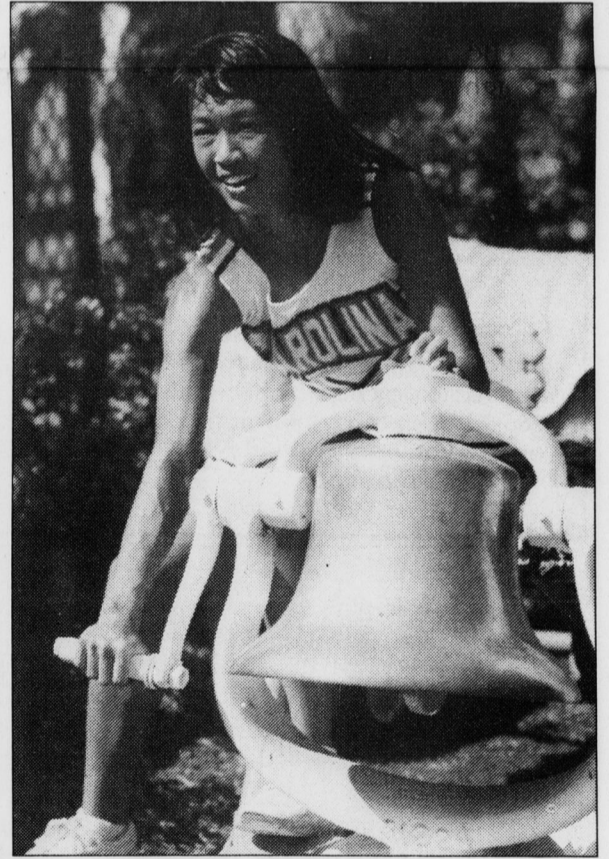
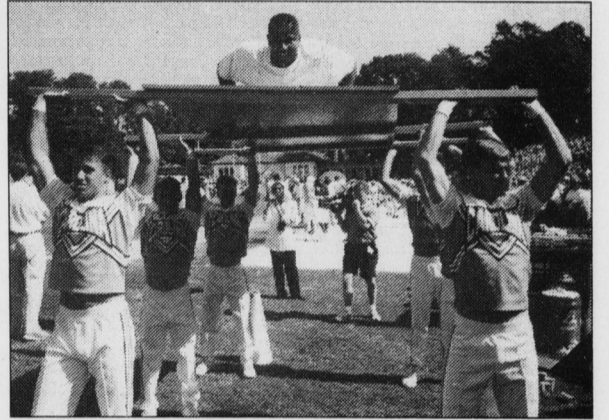
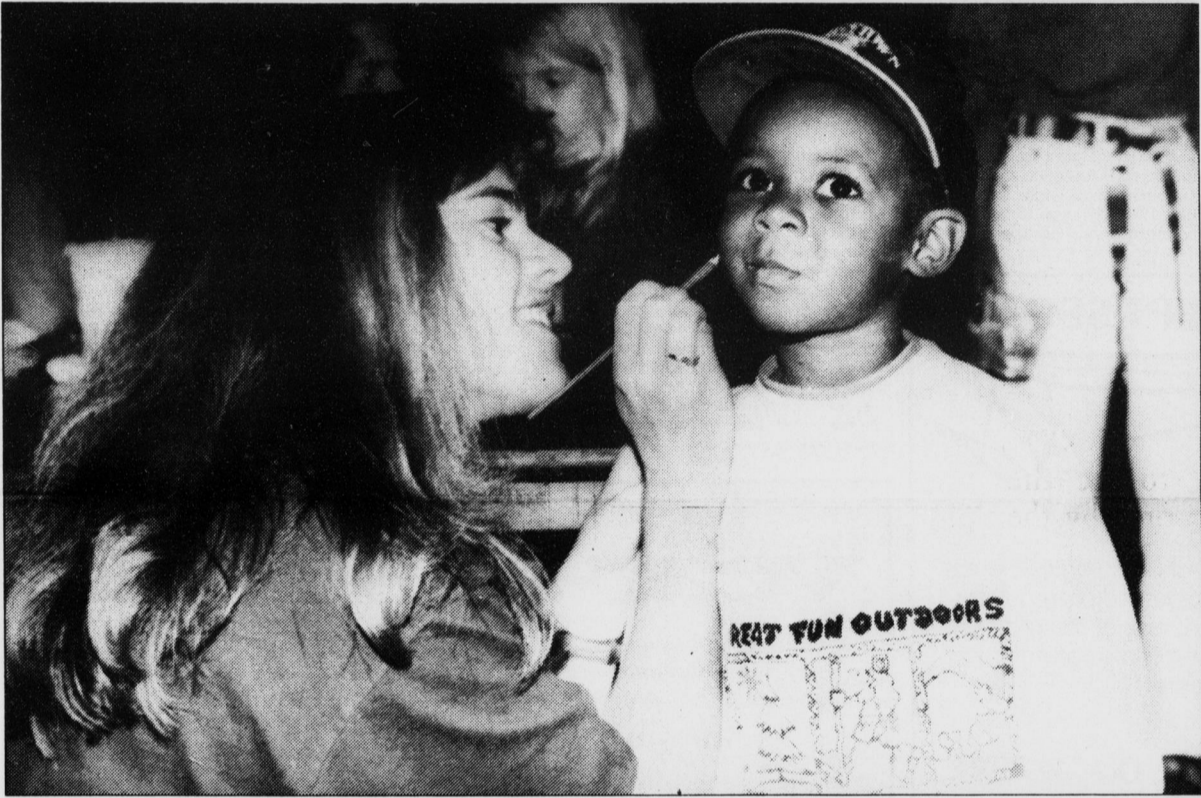
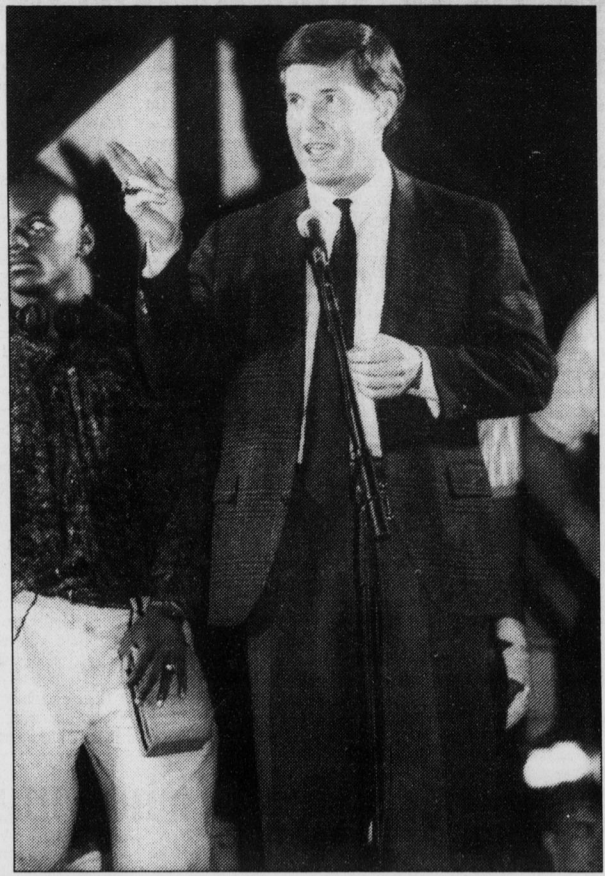


# Homecoming '93
