# After 16 Years, Caldwell Bids Adieu to Board of Alderman

**Alderman Hilliard Caldwell** will not seek re-election so he can spend more time with his family.

JULY 29 - Through the terms of four Carrboro mayors, Hilliard Caldwell has served his town and community as a fixof Aldermen. Caldwell

announced this week he would not pursue another term on the board and cited the desire to spend more time with his family as the rea-

"I'd like to be



able to visit (my family) without having to contend with something as important as a board meeting," he said.

Caldwell was first elected to the

board in 1981 and served continuously until 1993. He was re-elected to a fourth term in 1995

Caldwell said during his tenure in office he had pursued issues like the preservation of property rights, a cause that was close to his heart.

Mike Nelson, mayor of Carrboro, said Caldwell had been known as a

strong voice for "Old Carrboro," which refers to the town's long-time citizens. "He was born and raised there,"

Nelson said. "He speaks for Old Carrboro. I'm gonna miss him a lot."
Diana McDuffee, a Carrboro

Alderman, said serving on the board was a demanding task.

"The time it takes is daunting," McDuffee said.

She said members had to balance time between demanding careers and the 20- to 25-hour week required by the

A usual week often includes nights that require working well past midnight,

McDuffee said.

But Caldwell was modest and reflective when commenting on his time in

"I don't want to take credit for what the board has accomplished," he said. "Overall, I think controlled growth was

one of our main accomplishments." Although he has recently taken issue with campaign costs, which have risen dramatically during his years in office, Caldwell called his decision a personal one, prompted by his desire to spend more time with his family. Caldwell's wife is retired, and he has

a son in Colorado. He said he had not decided whether he would remain in Carrboro after he left office, but he was adamant about wanting more time to spend with his family.






