### Terrariums Fun To Construct And Are Easy To Care For

Terrariums-gardens enclosed in glass-are fun to make and easy to care for.

Any glass container that transmits light may be usedglobe, fish tank or large

Also, almost any house plant is suitable, especially those that like a high humidity. Plants most commonly used are African violet, maranta, begonia, coleus, croton, dracaena, ivy, peperomia, philodendron, pothos, and wandering Jew. But you can et your imagination be your guide and select any variety that will help make an inter-

esting display.

As for actual construction, the U. S. Department of Agriculture gives the following step-by-step instructions in its booklet on "Selecting and Growing House Plants."

Place a 1-inch layer of gravel, pebbles, broken flower pots, or charcoal in the bottom of the container. Dig moss from the woods and line the sides of the terrarium below the intended soil level.
