## Leaders Seeking Large Turnout In Leaf Vote

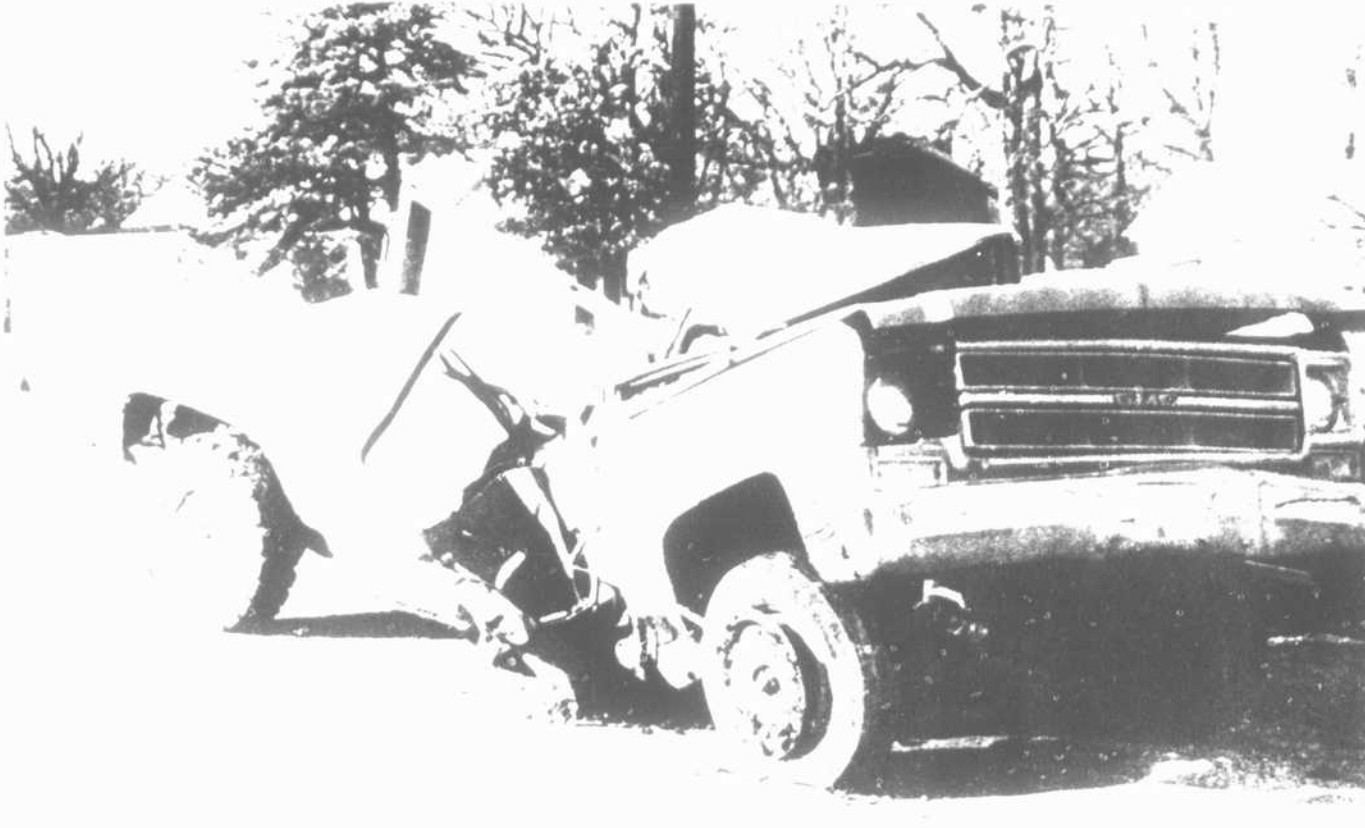
Four career tobacco growers throughout North Carolina are being urged to vote for a continuation of their marketing quota program and for their export promotion organization Tobacco Associates, Inc. The referendum is scheduled for Thursday, Dec. 23 to be held at regular ASUS polling places.

Deputy Harris of Mason county president pointed out that failure to support these programs would mean that there would be no quota controls and no price supports for future crops. The market development activities carried on by Tobacco Associates would also be terminated, he said.

Harris emphasized that quotas are the basis for price supports and are necessary if growers are to continue in profitable tobacco production. "Foreign market development for United States flue-cured tobacco is the prime objective of Tobacco Associates," Harris said. "The importance of export markets to the grower is vital. In the last crop year farmer income from flue-cured exports amounted to over \$900 aere of tobacco produced."
