

# Continuations Are Court Rule Of Day

Twenty of the 33 cases docketed for trial in Friday's district court were continued by Judge Charles W. Wilkinson of Oxford. The 13 cases heard were disposed of as follows:

Robert A. Bolton, nonsupport, ordered to jail for six months, suspended for two years on condition that he pay to office of Clerk of Superior Court \$50 each week for support of minor children and court costs.

Louis Davis, assault, not guilty.  
Bernard Stu Miller, driving under influence, ordered to jail for 30 days, suspended for six months on the condition that he surrender operator's license and not operate motor vehicle on highways, fined \$100 and court costs.

James E. Perkinson, driving under influence, driving while license revoked, ordered to jail for two years, suspended for three years and placed on probation for three years under usual rules of probation with special conditions that he attend alcoholic program at area mental health clinic, fined \$300 and court costs.

James Henry Ross, failure to stop at red light, voluntary dismissal.  
Junior Spruill, assault, not

guilty.  
Reginald Leon Valentine, failure to stop at red light, voluntary dismissal.  
John W. Wyche, Jr., worthless check, voluntary dismissal.

Richard Gregory Dean, felonious escape, waived right to preliminary hearing and ordered to appear at next criminal session of Superior Court with no bond set because defendant is incarcerated in the Department of Corrections.

K. R. Jackson appeared in court for a 96-hour hearing of second degree arson incurred in Franklin County.

Horace Green Morris, driving under influence, transporting broken sealed whiskey and failure to drive right half of highway, found guilty of D.U.I. and other charges dismissed. Ordered to jail for 30 days, suspended for six months on condition that he pay fine of \$100 and court costs and not operate motor vehicle on highways of N. C.

Sylvia Richardson, failure to comply with court order, ordered arrested for appearance on March 18 with bond set at \$50.

McKinley Silver, assault on female, ordered to jail for six months, suspended for one year on condition that he not be found guilty of assault and pay cost of court.


