Don't Judge **Peaches By** Their Red Blush

By JULIE BENDER N.C. State University

Delicious fresh peaches should not be judged by their blush, for the red color isn't always a good indicator of ripeness.

Instead, look at the background color, which should be creamy to a very mellow yellow, say NCSU agricultural extension specialists.

Also, look for well-defined creases.

Any green color on the peach indicates it might have been picked before it was fully mature and may be difficult to ripen as a result.

Peaches should be fairly firm to the touch, but don't touch too forcefully. Peachtemperature for a few days.


