Tarheel friends they loved you so dear They often wonder why you couldn't stay here.

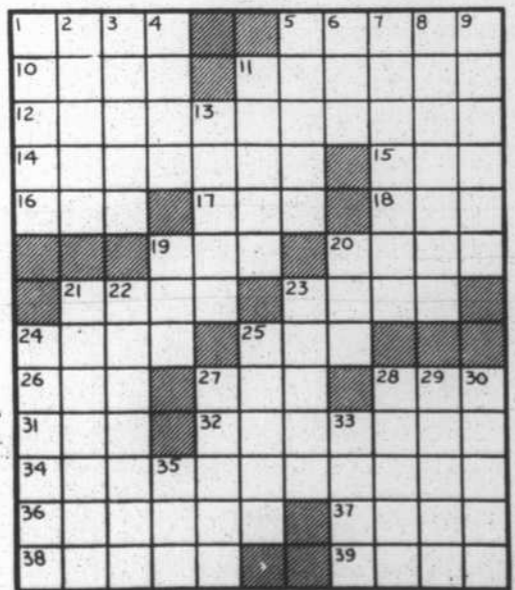

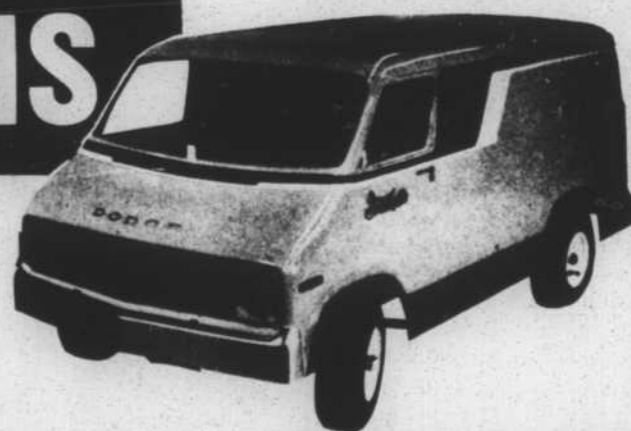
