Nationwide Team Wins Cook-Off

Top-place honors went to the "pig cookers" sponsored by Nationwide Insurance in the second annual "Pig Cook-Off" held last Saturday at the Lion's Den here.

The winning barbecue was prepared by a team of chefs that included Butch Meek, Dean Andrews, Dennis Harris, Donnie

Mulchi and Karen Daniel. The Nationwide team also grabbed the "showmanship award" in the contest.

The Nationwide team will now advance to state-level competition as it represents the Warrenton Merchants Association in the 1989 pig cook-off to be sponsored

by the N.C. Pork Producers Association.

Cal White and Jimmy Perkinson, under the sponsorship of Branch Banking & Trust Co., won the second-place trophy for their culinary delights. The third-place trophy was awarded to Brad Carroll and Ben Reavis, "cookers" sponsored by First Citizens Bank & Trust Co.

Participation in the event nearly doubled this year, with 14 teams competing as compared with only eight teams last year. Each of the 15 pigs cooked produced 35-40 pounds of barbecue.

Barbecue plate dinners were sold to area residents at a cost of \$3.50 each. The remaining barbecue was purchased by the Warrenton Lions Club for use at the Warren County Fair.

"The 1989 Pig Cook-Off was a big success," Woody King, Warrenton Merchants Association president, said Tuesday. "We had nearly twice as many pigs cooked with only about 100 pounds of barbecue left—an indication that, proportionately, sales were higher than last year," he concluded.

According to King, proceeds from the Pig Cook-Off will be split between the Warrenton Merchants Association and the Warren County Firemen's Association. The Merchants Association's portion of the funds will be used for town beautification projects and Christmas decorations for the town.

Walter Gardner, president of the Warrenton Firemen's Association, was unavailable for comment Tuesday on the association's plans for its portion of the proceeds. The monies raised in the 1987 Pig Cook-Off were put into an account for a firemen's relief fund and as "seed money" for a future training site to be located in Warren County.

Man Is Arrested For Potted Pot

A warrant has been drawn on a Macon man following the confiscation of 25 potted marijuana plants from a greenhouse behind his trailer last Friday night.

The warrant has been drawn on Carl P. Huggins, 37, of Rt. 2, Macon, on a felony charge of manufacturing a controlled substance.

The 25 marijuana plants that were confiscated from the Huggins greenhouse ranged in height from eight to 10 inches.

According to Sgt. Lawrence Harrison, no value has been given for the weed.

Assisting Sgt. Harrison in the investigation were Warrenton Police Officer C. R. Aycock, along with members of the Halifax County Sheriff's Department: Det. L. C. E. Ward, Sft. Don Stanfield, Deputy Richard Brown and Deputy Orlando Moody.

The marijuana has been stored as evidence in the case, Sgt. Harrison said.

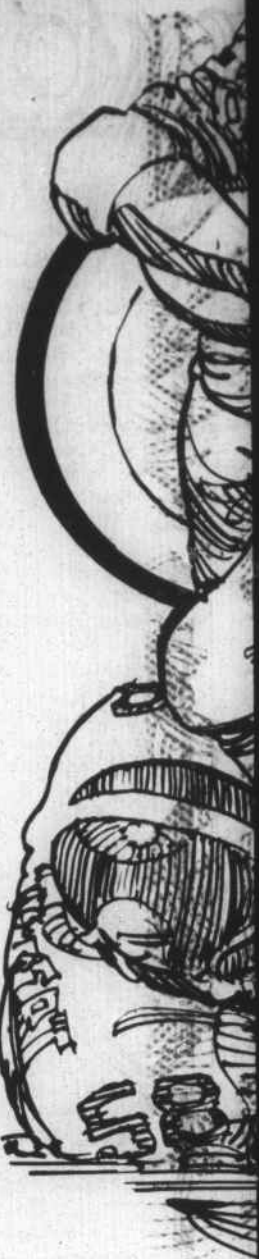
Don't let food sit out to cool before you put it in the refrigerator.
