DISTRICT WOMEN WANT McADOO FOR NOMINEE

McAdoo Leads in Club's Presidential Contest, With Henry Ford Next. E. E. Britton in News and Observer. Washington, May 2.—If the Democratic women of the District of Columbia could name the next president of the United States, it would be William Gibbs McAdoo, now of California, judging by the volume of applause that was given the mention of his name last night at the annual dinner of the Democratic Women's Club of the District.

Each woman who spoke did so with enthusiasm in behalf of the Presidential possibility whom she presented, and each speaker was given applause. But the applause for McAdoo "led all the rest" when he was presented as the best bet for democracy.

William Gibbs McAdoo was nominated, elected and sent to the White House for eight years," wrote one of the ladies for a newspaper in relating the enthusiasm for McAdoo. Henry Ford ran second to McAdoo only in the volume of applause which greeted the presentation of his name by his sponsors.

POLICE BATTLE MAN WHO THREATENS ROCKEFELLER

Assyrian, Armed With Stiletto, Captured in Front of Residence of John D. Jr. New York, May 2.—Armed with a stiletto and two long-waiver's needles, and Assyrian silk worker from Greenwich Village, who for two weeks had dogged the footsteps of John D. Rockefeller, Jr., was clubbed into submission today when he blocked the multimillionaire's exit from his West Fifty-fourth Street home and threatened to take his life.

The man gave the name of George Murad, 39, and said he had come from Canada a month ago looking for a job. Besides the weapons, he carried an Assyrian Bible, a notebook of directions to the city and country homes of John D. Rockefeller, Jr., and Jr., and a \$1 bill that a butler in the latter's home had given him this morning on his plea that he was "starving."
