

Recall the Draft Riots.

New York, July 13.—Sixty years ago today began the scenes of disorder and bloodshed which went down in history as bloodshed which went down in history as the New York draft riots. The conscription began Saturday, July 11, 1863, after strong objection had been voiced against the drafting of more recruits, on the ground that the war was practically over and that the order was a party measured. The riots began Monday following when a mob stoned and fired a recruiting office in 46th street. The rioting spread to all parts of the city, necessitating the calling of troops, in skirmish with whom the mob engaged for six days. Nearly a hundred were killed.
